Community Grants Scheme 2017

In 2016 a review of all grants for Community and Social Development was carried out. This review examined the process of the Community Grants scheme as it exists with the following objectives in mind :- quicker processing, more streamlining, transparency, less time consuming system, identifying overlaps, optimum use of IT, timely decisions, more clarity on criteria, evaluations etc.

The grants budget for 2017 was approved by the City Council as part of the annual budgetary process. The 2017 scheme closed on 28th October 2016 and 1,271 valid applications were received.

1,108 grants are hereby recommended to the City Council for approval. The total amount recommended is €957,472.00 which comprises €300,000 for local Area projects, €307,100.00 for City Wide, Social Inclusion and Integration projects, €86,472.00 for Informal Adult Education projects, €123,900.00 for the Tom Clarke Bridge Grant Scheme and €140,000.00 for Summer Projects. The Community and Social Development team will monitor grants awarded on the basis of terms and conditions during 2017.

The 2017 grants scheme will be reviewed with a view to further improving the process for 2018.

Dublin City Council is currently in the process of putting in place an on - line grant application system for Community Grants, Arts Grants, Sports Grants, Local Agenda 21 Grants and Local Enterprise Office Grants. Local Representatives will be kept informed of the on - line grant application system as it progresses.

Set out also in this report are details of the applications which have a City Wide, Social Inclusion and Integration remit together with recommendations in relation to the amount of grant assistance for each applicant body. It is recommended that Dublin City Council approve the grants to the Groups/Organisations as set out in this report.

City-wide Projects

1. Summer Projects

Crosscare manages the city's summer projects which are run by voluntary organizations on behalf of Dublin City Council. These summer projects have made a major contribution to youth development over the years. It is estimated that over 45 voluntary summer projects will take place citywide this summer catering for up to 10,000 children and with close to 1,500 workers. The Council's Community and Social Development staff will maintain close links with Crosscare and will assure that the highest standards in relation to both the range and extent of activities and childcare protection are maintained. Dublin City Council will manage the budget for the non-voluntary organizations of €50,000.

Amount of grant assistance recommended for Crosscare is €90,000.00 & DCC Summer projects €50,000, over all €140,000.00

2. FamilyBase

The Base, Ballyfermot Youth Centre and Childcare Facility Ltd and Familscope Ltd merged in March of 2014 and T/A Familybase. This was a survival strategy to secure vital frontline service delivery in the community. The merged organization delivers evidence based and informed programmes to parents, children, young people and families that support development across a number of areas eg: personal development, social development, emotional management/regulation, behaviour management, educational development and general well being.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €86,250.00

3. St Ultans Childcare Project

St Ultans works with the children and the community in the Cherry Orchard area. The work of St Ultans aims to break disadvantage through education and by providing an early intervention service. This grant enables St Ultans to run a campus that supports 500 children, their families and the community on a daily basis. The service is open 5 days a week, 48 weeks a year with a staff of 80 people.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €50,000.00

4. Age Action Ireland Limited

"Getting Started" is a project designed to develop the IT skills of residents of Dublin City Council's sheltered housing schemes. Training courses are co-ordinated by Age Action Ireland locations throughout the city using a team of more than one hundred volunteer trainers. Training is not limited to sheltered housing residents and older persons from the communities surrounding the complexes are encouraged to attend. In addition to the training provided there is a demand for more advanced courses in the use of mobile phones, tablets, digital cameras etc. and Age Action Ireland provides this where possible.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €31,250.00

5. The Fingal Centre

The Fingal Centre provides community, family and employment support services to the people of Finglas and surrounding areas. This grant will enable the centre to support development outreach work with the Traveller Community in the Area.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €20,000.00

6. St. Agnes Community Centre for Music and the Arts in Crumlin (CCMA)

The CCMA provides a platform for the entire community to have access to music and the arts. There are over 400 children and 100 adults involved in the centre. This grant will enable the CCMA develop the centre and it's musical and artistic programme.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €15,000.00

7. Cavan Centre

This centre has been in operation for over 30 years and provides a residential resource to support youth and community in marginalized and disadvantaged communities through a community development process. Through their "empowering communities" programme the centre provides invaluable educational, recreational and training experiences for participants who otherwise might not have such opportunities. It is anticipated that over 200 groups from the wider city area will avail of the resource in 2017.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €15,000.00

8. Lantern Centre

The Lantern Centre works to bridge the cultural and religious differences in our city and the hope is to facilitate the emergence of a society which is multicultural in purpose and composition. Up to 50 groups use the Lantern Centre for various activities such as inter faith dialogue, workshops, cultural group activities and educational group activities.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €5,000.00

9. Dublin Community Games

The City Council has been supporting the Dublin Community Games for many years. It provides many opportunities for children to engage in sporting activities, some of whom may progress to participate in their chosen sports at a more competitive level.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €5,000.00

10. The New Theatre

The New Theatre is a 66 seat venue in Temple Bar which focuses on nurturing and developing work with new artists. They are assisting with the administration and staging of The Ballyfermot Reach's annual presentation by providing professional, technical and artistic support. This grant will help fund that support programme.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €2,500.00

11. Dublin Community Growers

Dublin Community Growers is a network of Community Gardeners who meet on a monthly basis to discuss community gardening projects in the city and to also provide supports to community gardening groups. This grant will enable them to carry out events throughout the year such as training workshops and information sessions on all aspects of gardening which will take place in various community gardens in the city.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,250.00

12. Songs in the key of D

This choir was established in 2013 and has 76 members who come from a diverse and multicultural background. The grant will help the choir carry out their activities such as hiring rehearsal space, performance venues, printing music etc.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

13. One Family

One Family offers support, information and support services to all members of families. This grant will contribute to the production costs of the Family Day to be held in May 2017. Family Day will help promote their campaign to raise awareness regarding the diversity that exists in families today.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

14. Musical Youth Foundation

The Musical Youth Foundation is a registered children's charity and is dedicated to improving the lives of disadvantaged children by providing opportunities for them to access music education. This grant will enable the Music Youth Foundation fund their Guitar for Kids programme.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

15. North Dublin Befrienders Service

Befrienders Dublin is a free service for people with mental health difficulties. It provides opportunities for social interaction and companionship for people who experience isolation in the community. This grant will help fund the activities organised in a social setting by the service. Approximately 40 people from all over the city participate in such organized social activities such as Bingo and Karaoke nights.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €800.00

16. Forum Polonia

Forum Polonia brings together representatives of various Polish Community organizations, the media and individuals involved in projects relating to the Polish Community. This grant will go towards funding an event called 'The Polska Eire Festival' the aim of which is to further strengthen relations between Polish and Irish communities.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €800.00

17. Young Social Innovators

Young Social Innovators provides services and education programmes to all second level schools in Ireland, youth reach centres, and local and community centres across Dublin. This grant will contribute towards holding events called 'Speak Out'. These events give young people the opportunity to stand up and advocate their issues in public. The events will take place in the Mansion House where 400 young people will participate and other guests will be in attendance such as T.D's, guest speakers and decision makers.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €800.00

18. Childvision – Family Resources Department

Childvision is part of the National Centre for Blind Children in Drumcondra. This grant will enable the Family Resource Department carry out an all day event of activities such as yoga, arts and crafts and talks specifically tailored for the families of visually impaired children who attend the Campus of Childvision.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €600.00

19. Down Syndrome Dublin Saturday Art Fund

The Down Syndrome Saturday Club provides an active social outlet for people with Down Syndrome. This grant will contribute to the funding of the many activities carried out by the organizers who are mostly parents. There is a membership of over 350 families who participate from all over the city.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

20. Association of Irish Musical Societies

The Association of Irish Musical Societies provides a voice for musical societies in Ireland. They also provide support to the groups by way of advice on all aspects of musical productions.

This grant will help towards funding a youth workshop which will cover all aspects of staging a performance such as set design, stage management, etc.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

21. GRI Grupul Romanilor din Irlanda

This group provides social, cultural, educational and economic support and advice to the Romanian Community living in the South Inner City area of Dublin. This grant will enable the group to hold four events 1) Women's day in Romania, 2) International Children's Day, 3) Romania's National Day, 4) Christmas celebration festival.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

22. Innovista

Innovista in Ireland exists to see inner city communities flourishing through the positive contribution of young people to society. This grant will be used to part fund the RISE projects, a six week programme aimed at equipping teenagers with basic leadership skills.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

23. RADE (Recovery through Art, Drama, Education)

RADE engage recovering drug users with the arts and provide a platform for their artistic expression. This grant will enable RADE to develop a body of art work which will be put on exhibition in the Dublin City Council Atrium at Wood Quay.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

24. Salvation Army Support Flats

Lefroy House run by the Salvation Army is situated in the North East Inner City and is home to young people experiencing homelessness. This grant will go towards the Lefroy House environmental improvement project which will engage the young people in the house.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

25. Dyspraxia Ireland

Dyspraxia Ireland promotes the awareness of Dyspraxia through various volunteer programmes.

This grant will provide funding towards their 'Smart Moves Programme' which offers group occupational therapy services to children with dyspraxia.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €300.00

26. Dublin Afternoon Indoor Bowling League

There are over 30 clubs affiliated to the Indoor Bowling League who promote and organize Indoor Bowling competitions for older persons in the communities. This grant will enable the Indoor Bowling League to continue with their activities.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €300.00

27. Royal Canal Clean –Up Group

This voluntary group organizes monthly clean – ups along the Dublin City stretches of the Royal Canal. They are members of the Inland Waterways Association of Ireland. This grant will enable them to carry out their activities on a monthly basis.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €250.00

28. The Irish Model Soldier Society

The Irish Model Soldier Society promotes interest in the art of model making and painting of miniatures. This grant will enable the society to promote itself through its web site thus encouraging new membership.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €200.00

29. Discovery Gospel Choir

The Discovery Gospel Choir brings together people from different cultural backgrounds to perform inter-cultural choral music. This grant will help with the organization of six workshops where people from different cultural backgrounds can engage with one another and develop their musical skills.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €200.00

30. The Russian Show on Dublin City 103.2 FM

This volunteer radio programme reaches out to the people of Russia, Latvia, Lithuania, Ukraine and Estonia origin now living in Ireland, approximately 200,000. The programme also helps inform Irish Citizens about the the cultures and traditions of these countries. This grant will enable the programme to continue.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €200.00

31. OWLS – Children’s Nature Club

OWLS – Outdoor, Wildlife, Learning and Survival is a children’s nature charity based in Dublin whose aim is to provide children with education awareness and access to their natural environment. This grant will assist OWLS carry out a project in St. Annes Park where school children get involved in the management and growing of vegetables and herbs in an allotment.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €150.00

<u>SOCIAL INCLUSION</u>

1. The Irish Traveller Movement (ITM)

This grant will go towards the Yellow Flag Programme which is a progressive equality and diversity initiative designed by the ITM for primary and secondary schools promoting an environment of interculturalism for all children.

Amount of grant assistance recommended € 2,000.00

2. ACET (Aids Care Education & Training) Ireland

ACET is an interdenominational Christian response to HIV in Ireland. This grant will help fund training seminars for Ethnic Minorities on matters of mental health, sexual health and HIV.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,250.00

3. Flying South

Flying South is a mental health art collective who organize monthly themed arts events and have participated in the *First Fortnight Festival, Lingo Spoken Word Festival and Dublin City Council’s Social Inclusion Week*. This grant will enable the group carry out their monthly activities.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

4. European Youth in Migration Forum (EYMF) /under the umbrella of the Irish Refugee Council in Ireland (1).

EYMF is a group of young people from all over the world living in Ireland whose aim is to improve the protection of youth migrants in Ireland and Europe. This grant will fund a youth café summer programme by providing a safe location and environment which helps young people, some of whom are living in direct provision come together to build relationships and integrate into the wider community.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

5. European Youth in Migration Forum (2).

This grant will enable EYMF carry out a range of activities such as an Art project, Craft workshops etc in their Youth Café.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €800.00

6. Greater Dublin Independent Living (GDIL)

GDIL is an organization of people with disabilities who seek to empower people with disabilities by helping them enhance their quality of life and achieve independent living. This grant will help fund the Solidarity Event which will offer people with a disability an opportunity to network and gain valuable information on independent living.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €800.00

7. Friends of the Elderly

Friends of the elderly works to reduce isolation and loneliness among older people by providing social engagement opportunities. This grant will help fund their 'Keep my Brain Healthy Programme' which includes a physical activity club, a technology club and a social meeting club.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €800.00

8. ALONE (1).

ALONE is an independent charity that works with older people who are homeless, socially isolated, living in deprivation or in crisis. This grant will go towards the training programme for volunteers who are recruited four times a year.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €700.00

9. ALONE (2).

ALONE is an independent charity that works with older people who are homeless, socially isolated, living in deprivation or in crisis. This grant will go towards the organization of six social events that take place throughout the year such as visiting the Botanic Gardens and the Theatre Festival.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

10. BeLong to Youth Services Ltd

BeLong To is a national youth service for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender (LGBT) young people in Ireland. This grant will assist BeLongTo deliver their flag ship service 'BeLong to Sunday' which provides young people with a safe and inclusive space to meet.

Amount of grant assistance recommended € 500.00

11. Headway Ireland Ltd (1)

Headway's aim is to bring positive changes into the lives of those affected by an acquired brain injury. This grant will enable the organization to facilitate their clients engage in the Re-Integration Service in Dublin by participating in the Social and Health Education Project.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

12. Headway Ireland Ltd (2)

Headway's aim is to bring positive changes into the lives of those affected by an acquired brain injury. This grant will enable the organization to participate in Culture Night 2017 by holding a broad exhibition of the work carried out by clients in their Rehabilitative Centres.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

13. First Fortnight

First Fortnight is a charity based organization with the express aim of challenging mental health prejudice through the creative arts. This grant will help fund two elements of the First Fortnight 2017 festival, 'Co-Motion' helps people create playlists with others and 'Conversation Salon' provides a safe environment for people to meet and talk.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €400.00

14. Exchange House Ireland

Exchange House Ireland provides Traveller specific family support, crisis intervention, education, training and services for children and young people in Ireland. This grant will enable Exchange House to host the National Traveller Education Achievement Awards.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €600.00

Integration

1. Dublin City Interfaith Forum

The Dublin City Interfaith Forum works to support and strengthen the contribution of faith communities towards social and civic integration. This grant will enable DCIF to carry out a range of activities such as 'Faith in the City' Programme, UN Interfaith Harmony Seminar, and Interfaith Peace Activity Programme.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €13,000.00

2. Akidwa/ Akina Dada wa Africa Ltd

Akidwa aims to promote the equality of migrant women in Irish Society. This grant will help fund an integration internship scheme for young 1st and 2nd generation migrants in Ireland. This grant will enable Akidwa continue with capacity building activities that include health promotion, DIY Training etc

Amount of grant assistance recommended €5,500.00

3. Experience Japan

The Experience Japanese Festival committee aim to promote a deeper understanding of Japanese culture and to enable the Japanese community develop relationships with Irish community organizations. This grant will go towards the Hanami (Cherry Blossom Spring) Festival in Farmleigh, a children's workshop in the Chester Beatty Library and language classes and Seminars on Japanese culture and traditions to be held in various locations throughout the city.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €5,000.00

4. Migrants Rights Centre Ireland

Migrants Rights Centre Ireland is a national organisation concerned with the inclusion and integration of migrant workers who may be at risk or experiencing poverty, social exclusion and discrimination within Irish Society. This grant will be used by MRCI to support vulnerable migrants by developing their outreach programmes, their Youth Empowerment Project, Leadership and development training, and the Migrants Forum

Amount of grant assistance recommended €3,000.00

5. Immigrant Council of Ireland

The Immigrant Council of Ireland is an independent immigrant human rights organization which works with and for immigrant's .It advocates for the rights of immigrants and their families and acts as a catalyst for public debate and policy change. This grant will provide crucial support to the ICI Team in delivering its Racist Incident Support and Referral Service, it's anti racism campaign in conjunction with Dublin Bus, Irish Rail and the National Transport Authority.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €3,000.00

6. New Communities Partnership

New Communities Partnership (NCP) is an independent national network of 126 ethnic minority led groups comprising of 75 nationalities with offices in Dublin, Cork and Limerick. This grant will help deliver a series of initiatives aimed at promoting and fostering Integration, Social Inclusion and active participation of Ethnic Minorities in Dublin City.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €2,500.00

7. Ethiopian Community in Ireland

This is a non for profit organization aiming to help integrate Ethiopians living in Ireland into their new communities. This grant will support the holding of an 'Ethiopian Day' event in 2017.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,500.00

8. Islamic Foundation of Ireland (IFI) (1)

IFI cater for the religious, cultural and social needs of Muslims in Ireland. This grant will enable the IFI to run a wide range of activities throughout the year such as their drug awareness programme, their youth and children programmes covering topics such as communication skills, martial arts, healthy eating, workshops on active citizenship etc.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

9. Islamic Foundation of Ireland (IFI) (2)

The IFI will also run an information project on the Muslim community through the medium of photographic exhibitions and food fair events. The format will be of two open days with approximately 250 people visiting the mosque per day.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

10. SARI Sport Against Racism Ireland

SARI promotes and supports cultural integration and social inclusion through sports using programmes and events which brings people together while creating awareness around racism. This grant will fund 'Soccernites' which is a training programme for boys and girls aged 14-18.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,250.00

11. MIND Malayalee Indians

MIND is a voluntary community organization established to provide a platform for Malayalee Indians to promote their rich culture, heritage and traditions within their new Irish context. This grant will contribute towards the hosting of the 'Thiruvonam' harvest festival.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,250.00

12. Amal Group (1)

The Amal group works with women who use the Dublin Mosque and who may feel isolated and voiceless in their community. The grant will help fund and strengthen the support service provided by the group through their drop in centre which enables the women to meet and organize activities such as hosting public events, youth activities etc. Funding will also go towards the childcare cost associated with the centre.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,250.00

13. Amal Group (2)

The Amal group works with women who use the Dublin Mosque and who may feel isolated and voiceless in their community. The grant will part fund courses, information seminars and training programmes for adult women and men, all teenagers and also children and will incorporate subjects such as personal development, civic consciousness, computers, parenting, and English language.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

14. AMBI- Brazilian Mothers Association in Ireland

Ambi aims to integrate the Brazilian Families living in Dublin and Ireland. They run monthly events celebrating Brazilian culture and also Portuguese language classes. This grant will enable them to continue with their activities.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,250.00

15. Irish Modern Dance Theatre (IMDT)

IMDT is a culturally diverse, multi generational ensemble of dancers and choreographers combining Irish dancers with outstanding international dance artists and Dublin based migrants and torture survivors. This grant will enable IMDT fund a series of integrating, process led workshops with disadvantaged migrant groups.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €1,000.00

16. Dublin Greek Film Festival

This group aims to showcase Greek and Cypriot culture through a variety of award winning films that have never been screened in Ireland. In 2016 almost 800 people attended the screenings which were held in The New Theatre, Filmbase and the Sugarclub.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €800.00

17. Bahar Centre for Intercultural Collaboration

The Bahar Centre for Intercultural Collaboration is a non-religious, non political, not for profit organization dedicated to celebrating and promoting Middle Eastern and Asian Art and Culture in Ireland. This grant will help fund a music and poetry event with a focus on intercultural dialogue between the Pakistani, Middle Eastern and Asian Communities in Ireland. The event will be located in TCD.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €800.00

18. Silk road Film Festival

This film festival promotes cultural diversity and is affiliated with organizations such as Asia Matters, Bahar Centre for Cultural Collaboration, Turkish Cultural Society, Chester Beatty Library, Hello China and the Dublin Chinese New Year Festival. This grant will enable the organizing committee to carry out the Silk Road Film Festival scheduled for March 2017.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €750.00

19. Dublin 7 Integration Initiative

This group runs monthly welcome café events in the Third Space Café, D7 for migrants and refugees giving them practical advice and support in a safe and friendly environment. This grant will enable the group to continue with their activities with a view to widening their target audience which is already at about 200 participants and to run two larger intercultural celebrations in 2017.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €750.00

20. Polish Teachers Association

The Polish Teachers Association promotes Polish and European languages and culture by running a Polish Weekend School in Dublin with approximately 450 participants. This grant will enable them continue with this programme of English language classes throughout the year.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €750.00

21. Irish Polish Society (1). See No 32 for (2)

The Irish Polish Society aims to promote the integration, cultural exchange and networking between the Irish people and the Polish Diaspora. This grant will help fund their Annual Arts Exhibition in September /October 2017 which is open to the public and held in various venues in the city such as DCC Civic Offices, The Bank of Ireland Arts Centre, and The ILAC Centre Library.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

22. Latin America Solidarity Centre (LASC) (1). See No 35 for (2)

The LASC is an initiative of cultural promotion, development, education and solidarity that aims to link Latin America and Ireland. This grant will help fund a Latin American Festival (Cinco de Mayo Festival) incorporating music and dance, crafts, food stalls etc. This event will take place in The Dublin Food Co-Op and attendance is expected to be about 500.

Amount of grant assistance recommended €500.00

23. ENAR (European Network Against Racism) Ireland (1). See No 33 for (2)

ENAR is a national network of anti-racism NGO's which collectively aims to highlight and address the issue of racism in Ireland. This grant will help fund a workshop for Dublin's ethnic communities and organizations.
