Recent actions and topics

- Fingal County Council will lodge Part VIII planning application in first quarter 2017 regarding the Moyne Road / Hole in the Wall Road improvements.
- The Medical Centre in Clongriffin is complete and it is hoped to be opening soon. The tenant is in negotiations with Doctors to take over the practice.
- A Polish food shop is due to open on Main Street, Clongriffin early in 2017.
- A Care Centre opened in Block 12, Clongriffin.
- Further information has been requested regarding block 17 planning application. This is located beside the DART station. This will be a landmark building for Clongriffin reaching 16 storeys high, consisting of 139 residential units and 5 commercial units.
- Planning has been lodged for 23 units on Beltree Avenue / Marrsfield Avenue.
- The change of use application for the former department store has been lodged, this will facilitate an open plan office environment.
- It is envisioned that planning application will be lodged for block 19 (200 bed hotel), block 25 (48 units), block 26 (71 units) and block 27 (48 units) in early 2017.
- Discussions are ongoing with prospective tenants for two other units in Clongriffin.
- Works progressing in Belmayne, Parkside development, with Phase 1 which include 166 homes.
 Sales are ongoing with few units available.
- Construction has commenced on Phase 2 of Parkkside adjacent to schools on Parkside Boulevard.
- It is anticipated that the Green Link will be open by Spring 2017.
- Area Office Community Section assisted Park Avenue Residents Association who held a "Meet & Greet your Neighbour Day" which was held on 10th December 2016.
