TERENURE DISTRICT

- There has been 26 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs to date this year (40 for the same period in 2015).
- There have been 49 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2016 as opposed to 36 for the same period last year, an increase of 36%.
- There has been 0 Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2016 (1 in 2015).
- 77 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2016 as opposed to 102 in 2015, a decrease of 25%.
- 14 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2016 (19 in 2015).
- 99 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2016 (74 in 2015, an increase of 34%).

SUNDRIVE SUB-DISTRICT

- There have been 23 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs to date this year (23 in 2015).
- There have been 23 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2016 as opposed to 12 for the same period last year, an increase of 92%.
- There are no Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2016 (0 in 2015).
- 62 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2016 as opposed to 81 in 2015, a decrease of 23%.
- 18 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2016 (21 in 2015).
- 42 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2016 (60 in 2015, a decrease of 30%).
