



Proposal to rename Belmont Court as Woods Way / Bealach Mhic Conchoille

Dublin City Council, at its meeting of 25th July 2016, having considered Report 221/2016, directed that a plebiscite be taken in relation to the proposed change of name of the lane currently known as Belmont Court to Woods Way / Bealach Mhic Conchoille.

At the city council meeting held on the 9th January 2017, the city council adopted a list of qualified electors for the purpose of a plebiscite. The result of the plebiscite was:

No. of ballot papers issued:	1
No. of completed ballot papers returned:	1
No. of persons who voted in favour of the proposal:	1
No. of persons who voted against the proposal:	0

This confirmed that a majority of qualified electors are in favour of the renaming proposal, thereby satisfying the requirements of Section 78 of the Local Government Act, 1946, and the Local Government (Changing of Place Names) Regulations, 1956 (as amended by Section 67 of Local Government Act, 1994).

I recommend that the City Council agrees to the renaming of the lane currently known as Belmont Court to Woods Way / Bealach Mhic Conchoille.
