Proposal to declare the roads & footpaths at The Mews, Castle Avenue, Clontarf, Dublin 3 to be public roads & footpaths

The legal procedure to declare the roads & footpaths as detailed above to be public roads & footpaths was initiated under Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993, as set out in Subsections 4 and 5 of Section 180 Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended by Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010

The proposal is shown on attached copy Drawing No R.M. 36648.

At its meeting on 19th December 2016 the North Central Area Committee recommended that the necessary statutory procedure be initiated with a view to "taking in charge" the aforementioned roads & footpaths.

By public advertisement on the 13th January 2017 representations or objections were invited before 6th March 2017.

<u>Note</u>: The Parks Department have no objection to the green area on the left hand side as you enter the estate being taken in charge however they will be unable to maintain it to the current standard. All of the flower borders and raised planting areas in front of the houses are considered private property and will not be included in the maintenance of the green space in The Mews, Castle Avenue, Clontarf, Dublin 3.

The declaration of a road to be a public road under the provisions of Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993, as set out in Subsections 4 and 5 of Section 180 Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended by Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010 is a reserved function.
