

## Breviate of Meeting of the Corporate Policy Group Held on the 24th February 2017

- 1) Minutes of Meeting held on 27 January 2017 Agreed.

- 3) Update from SPC Chairs

The Deputy Lord Mayor requested that as Moscow City was due in at 3.30 pm that only SPC Chairs that had meetings would give update.

- a) Arts, Culture & Recreation Cllr. Rebecca Moynihan No Meeting
- b) Economic Development & Enterprise Cllr. Paul McAuliffe
  Report commissioned from economist Ronan Lyons on impact on Dublin
  Economy of housing shortages. Report to be available in April. Chairs
  of Economic Strategic Policy Committee in four Dublin Local Authorities
  are to meet to coordinate strategies.
- c) Environment Cllr. Naoise O'Muiri

The commencement of testing of the Waste to Energy Plant to begin in March. The SPC has also been looking at issues around the segregation of waste in social housing complexes and apartment blocks.

d) Finance - Cllr. Ruairi McGinley Cllr McGinley sent apologies.

### e) Housing - Cllr. Daithi Doolan

Cllr Doolan outlined presentation from Housing Finance Agency at Housing SPC and implications of increased borrowing. A report on implications of AirBNB on housing market. HAP mainstream to commence in March. Cllr. Doolan and other Councillors were asked to attend CPD session for DCC architects which led to an exchange of views on timetable for housing delivery. Cllr. McAuliffe and Cllr. Ó Muirí raised questions about social mix in projects other than Land Initiatives as there seemed to be misunderstanding at Council level on what DCC policy was in relation to this issue.

### f) Planning & Property Development - Cllr. Andrew Montague

The Minister for Housing, Planning and Local Government has written to the Lord Mayor and requested that councillors put Ireland 2040 National

Planning Framework on the agenda for the next Council meeting. It is being discussed at the SPC meeting next week. Discussion took place on how this should be managed at the meeting and how it should feed into consultation process.

## g) Transportation - Cllr. Ciaran Cuffe

Cllr Cuffe was absent but Councillors present requested more information on proposed changes to bus lanes on the Quays and routes available to motorists crossing the City. Brendan O'Brien gave the background to the changes on the Quays which was largely necessitated by Cross City Luas and increased length of LUAS trams which needed to traverse O'Connell Bridge and Rosie Hackett Bridge in one movement or quays would be congested. The bus lanes were out for public consultation.
