**Proposal to initiate the procedure to extinguish the Public
Right of Way over a laneway at
2-10 Clonard Road, Dublin 8.**

Proposal

Dublin City Council has received a request from local residents to extinguish the public right of way at the above address. There are issues with illegal dumping and concerns with rear access security at this location. Residents feel that to block off access to this roadway would be a positive move in addressing the problems. It is proposed to restrict access with lockable gates.

The extent of the proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached **Drawing Ref RM 37066**.

Statutory Requirement

The statutory procedure involves giving public notice of the proposal in one or more newspapers circulating in the City, and the affixing of a site notice for a period of not less than 14 days. Any objections or representations made and not withdrawn shall be considered. The extinguishment of a public right of way is a function reserved to the elected members of the City Council.

Service Check

A check is being carried out to establish what services, if any, are located at this location. Suitable agreements will be put in place prior to the completion of this proposal, if required.

Recommendation

I recommend that procedures be initiated under Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993 to extinguish the public right of way over the area indicated on **Drawing Ref. RM 37066**.
