**With reference to a proposal for the
Extinguishment of the Public Right of Way over Wellington Place North, Dublin 7**

Proposal

A request to have the public right of way extinguished over **Wellington Place North, Dublin 7** has been made.

The reason for this extinguishment is to eliminate anti-social behaviour, including dumping, in the referred road. The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached Drawing RM 23216.

Statutory Requirement

By public advertisement, on the 13th July 2018, representations or objections were invited to be received on or before the 21st day of August 2018. The site notices were erected on the 13th July 2018.

One objection was received.

Service Check

A service check has been carried out and no service provider will need to alter the current services on or under the referred Wellington Place North.

Accessibility arrangements, for such service providers, shall be made through the Central Area Office or those private customers that are engaged with that service provider(s).

Public Lighting will remove the lamp standards from the road.

Recommendation

I recommend that procedures be initiated, under Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993, to extinguish the public right of way over the area indicated on attached Drawing RM 23216.
