



Affordable Dwelling Purchase Arrangements – Order of Priority where Applications Exceed Dwellings

Affordable Dwelling Purchase Arrangements – Household Priority Levels

Priority Level 1 (E) (Highest Priority)

- Eligible Applicants
- Dwelling suits Household's needs
- Living in the Area for at least 12 months immediately preceding application
- A member of the household attending education locally
- A member of the household working locally

Priority Level 2 (C)

- Eligible Applicants
- Dwelling suits Household's needs
- Living in the Area for at least 12 months immediately preceding application
- A member of the household attending education locally
- A member of the household working locally

Priority Level 3 (D)

- Eligible Applicants
- Dwelling suits Household's needs
- Living in the Area for at least 12 months immediately preceding application
- A member of the household attending education locally
- A member of the household working locally

Priority Level 4 (B)

- Eligible Applicants
