**With reference to a proposal to extinguish the Public Right of Way over a laneway at 2-10 Clonard Road, Dublin 12.**

---

**Proposal**

The South Central Area Committee, at its meeting on the 20<sup>th</sup> Feb 2019, agreed to initiate the statutory procedures to extinguish the public right of way at the above address and allow the erection of lockable gates within the laneway set back from the entrance.

The extent of the proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached drawing R.M 37066.

**Statutory Requirement**

By public advertisement in the Irish Indept. on Fri. 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019. Representations or objections were invited by the 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2019 and a site notice was erected at the location.

**Service Check**

Service providers have been informed of this proposal and their requirements will be facilitated.

**Recommendation**

The South Central Area Committee, at a meeting held on the 15<sup>th</sup> May 2019, having considered a report on this proposal, agreed that the right of way be extinguished. The extinguishment of a public right of way under Section 73 of the Roads Act, 1993 is a function reserved to the City Council.

**Resolution:**

“That We, the Lord Mayor and Members of Dublin City Council, being the Roads Authority for the City of Dublin and being of the opinion that the Public Right of Way over Lane at over a laneway at 2-10 Clonard Road, Dublin 12, as shown on the attached Drawing No RM. 37066, is no longer required for public use, extinguish the public right of way in accordance with Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993”.
