Report No. 244/2019 Report of the A/Assistant Chief Executive



With reference to the proposed Disposal of multiple plots to the rear of properties 11-17 Gortmore Drive, Finglas, Dublin 11.

When Dublin City Council proposed to construct 40 rapid build homes the owners of adjacent homes Nos. 11- 17 Gortmore Drive voiced objections. The concerns in the main related to the protection of an existing line of trees and the properties backing directly onto the site of the proposed development.

Following consultation it was proposed by the North West Area Office to reduce the number of rapid build homes to 39 and to construct a new boundary wall 7 metres from the existing rear boundaries of the properties to incorporate and therefore protect the line of existing trees which are now within the subject plots. In so doing the residents gain an additional plot each at the rear of their existing gardens which vary in size from 38- 65 sq m. New party fence divisions have also been constructed.

The land is owned in Fee Simple by Dublin City Council. The proposed sites are outlined red on the attached Maps SM- 2017-0399 to 0405. Agreement has now been reached for the disposal of the Council's interest in the plots subject to the following terms and conditions which are considered to be fair and reasonable:

1. That Dublin City Council disposes of the Council's interest with no consideration in the subject plots at no's 11-17 (Inclusive) Gortmore Drive, Finglas, Dublin 11 to the homeowners set out in the schedule below.

- 2. That the subject plots are shown outlined in red on the attached map Index No. SM-2017-0399 to 0405.
- 3. That Dublin City Council shall transfer the freehold title or equivalent in the subject plots.
- 4. The applicants shall be responsible for demolishing and disposing of the original existing rear walls and bear the cost of same.
- 5. That the applicants hold the freehold title or equivalent interest in their respective properties no's 11-17 Gortmore Drive, Finglas, Dublin 11.

- 6. Dublin City Council shall be responsible for its own legal fees in the matter.
- 7. The disposal shall be subject to any such covenants and conditions as the Law Agent in his discretion shall stipulate.

DCC acquired the fee simple in the property from Reps John Craigie in 1968 and are registered to DCC under Folio DN1894

No agreement enforceable at law is created or intended to be created until exchange of contracts has taken place.


