

With reference to a proposal to initiate the procedure for the Extinguishment of the Public Right of Way over a section of footpath on Railway Street, that forms part of Railway Street, Dublin 1

Proposal

A request to have the public right of way extinguished over a section of footpath on Railway Street that forms part of Railway, Dublin 1 has been made.

The reason for this extinguishment is to allow the City Council dispose of the fee simple, for that section of Railway Street, to an approved housing body (Circle Housing Association). This is facilitate Circle Housing Association to develop the adjoining site for social housing support purposes.

The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached Drawing SM-2019-0132.

Statutory

By public advertisement, on the 19th February 2019, representations or objections were invited to be received by or before the 1st day of April 2019. The site notices was erected on the 19th February 2019.

No objections were received.

Service Check

A service check has been carried out and communication services providers have advised of ducts and cable pathways adjoining and under the referred site. Arrangements for the service providers shall be made through the Central Area Office or thereafter through Circle Housing Association for such access or relocating works of the services from to the referred section of footpath.

Recommendation

I recommend that procedures be initiated under Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993 to extinguish the public right of way over the area indicated on attached Drawing SM-2019-0132.

Resolution:

That We, the Lord Mayor and Members of Dublin City Council, being the Roads Authority for the City of Dublin and being of the opinion that the Public Right of Way over a section of footpath on Railway Street, that forms part of Railway Street, Dublin 1, as shown on the attached Drawing No SM-2019-0132, is no longer required for public use, extinguish the public right of way in accordance with Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.
