**With reference to a proposal to initiate the procedure for the  
extinguishment of the public right of way at that part of Bella Street,  
Dublin 1 (otherwise known as Rutland Cottages).**

### **Proposal**

A request to have the public right of way extinguished over that part of the road and path that forms part of Bella Street, Dublin 1 (otherwise known as Rutland Cottages) has been made. The reason for this extinguishment is to eliminate anti-social behaviour and waste dumping over that part of the road and path of Bella Street that is a cul-de-sac. The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached Drawing.

### **Service Checks**

A service check will be undertaken to establish what (if any) services are located in the area as shown on the attached Drawing. Suitable arrangements will be put in place regarding all such services prior to completion of this proposal.

### **Statutory Requirement**

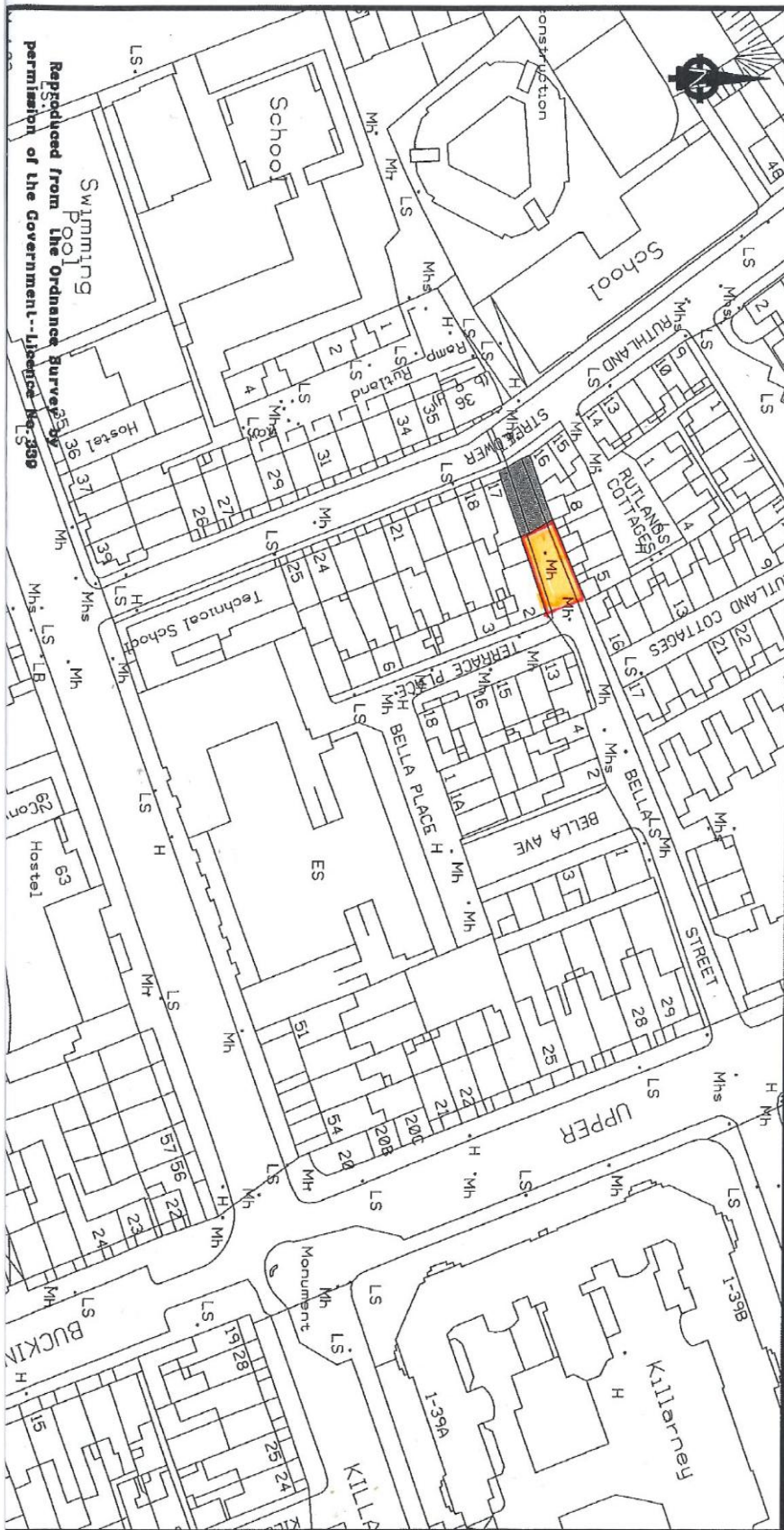
The statutory procedure involves giving public notice of this proposal in one or more newspapers circulating in the City and the affixing of that notice at each end of the referred right of way for a period of not less than 14 days. Any objections or representations made and, not withdrawn, shall be considered. The extinguishment of a public right of way is a function reserved to the elected members of the City Council.

### **Recommendation**

I recommend that procedures be initiated under Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993 to extinguish the public right of way over the area indicated on attached Drawing.
