The speed survey found that Bulfin Gardens is an extremely lightly trafficked road and that the 85th percentile is only showing at 24km/h which is below the new 30Km/h speed limit. During the survey it was noted that there was only 0.30% of the traffic that broke the speed limit.</p> <p>Also during a site visit it was noticed that Kickham Road has a School ahead sign (which is actually in the wrong place and will have to be moved ) at the entrance. I think the residents have mistaken this as an additional children at play sign.</p> <p>Both Kickham Road and Bulfin Road have the new 30km/h signs which serve as a 3-in-1 sign. Incorporated into these new signs there is a "children at play" and "Slow Zone" sign along with the speed limit. This is to warn motorists that it's a residential area and to expect children.</p> <p>At present, the Engineer doesn't feel like any additional traffic calming measures need to be done.</p>	Councillor	06/08/2019	0
