

With further reference to the proposed development of a site at Finglas Road /Tolka Valley Road, Dublin 11

Report No. 124/2003 and 135/2004 which were assented to by the City Council at its meetings on the 7th April 2003 and the 26th April 2004 respectively, contained the terms and conditions for a joint venture/public private partnership arrangement with McCabe Builders Ltd, to develop a site at Finglas Rd/Tolka Valley, to provide residential/commercial accommodation and car parking facilities.

Report No. 132/2003 assented to at the City Council at its meeting on the 9th May 2005, contained terms to dispose of the fee simple in three substations within the complex to the ESB.

The legal formalities have not yet completed and as these substations are part of multi-storey buildings, it is therefore proposed to grant a 99 year lease in each of these three sites to the ESB subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The sites will be transferred to the ESB for the sum of one euro.
- 2. The disposal shall be subject to all statutory easement rights of the ESB.
- The ESB shall be granted a wayleave over the areas coloured yellow on the attached map index numbers SM-2015-0965 DWG No 001, SM-2015-0965 DWG No 002 and SM-2015-0965 DWG No 003.
- 4. The E.S.B shall pay a contribution of €750 (seven hundred and fifty euros) towards the City Council's legal costs incurred in the transaction together with VAT and reasonable outlay.
- 5. Any additional conditions required in the lease regarding the structural issues relating to the walls, columns, ceilings, floors etc. in the building will be agreed at the legal formalities stage.

The sites proposed to be disposed of were acquired from the Craigie Estate, Patrick Gleeson, James Gleeson and Walter Farrelly.

No agreement enforceable at law is created or intended to be created until an exchange of contracts has taken place.

The disposal shall be subject to any such covenants and conditions as the Law Agent in his discretion shall stipulate.

This report is submitted in accordance with the requirements of Section 183 of the Local Government Act, 2001.

Resolution to be adopted "That Dublin City Council notes the contents of Report No. 363/2019 and assents to the proposal outlined therein".
