Naming Proposal for laneway located at 1-59 Howth Road, Clontarf, Dublin 3.

Charlemont Lane, Clontarf, Dublin 3

A request was received from an architect to number a new property in the back garden of a premises on Howth Road, Clontarf, Dublin 3. The new property will face out into a laneway which is known locally as Charlemont Lane. There are no records confirming a formal naming of this laneway. There are currently 4 live planning applications for the construction of new properties in the rear gardens of houses along 1-59 Howth Road. These new properties will front onto the laneway so on the advice of the Planning Department it is necessary to formally name the laneway so that the new properties can be given addresses. The laneway is indicated on the attached drawing **RM 37340**.

This laneway was once part of the estate of the 1st Earl of Charlemont and the main entrance to his estate was on the north fringe of Dublin in Fairview hence the reason for its name.

The name has been approved by the Heritage Officer and the Irish translation has been approved by the Irish Office
