Not Recommended	SR Not Recommended -This area is within the new speed limits is set by Dublin City Council for residential areas. As part of the new limits "Speed limit" signs are erected at all points where there is a change of speed limit (Eg.Cooley Road at the junction with Crumlin Road and Errigal Road at the junction of Drimnagh Road). Incorporated into these new signs there is a "Home Zone" and "Slow Zone" sign along with the speed limit. This is to warn motorists that it's a residential area and to expect children. It is felt that this sign would be sufficient to warn motorists and a further 4 Children at play signs would be proliferation. The Area Engineer also would not recommend installing ramps or this carriageway as it does not meet the criteria. Ramps aren't installed on roads that have a 30km/h speed limit, the road should be 200m in a straight line, traffic volumes should exceed 60 vehicles per hour and there should be visible speeding on the road.
