Monthly Local Fund Statement

Background

Attached for consideration by the elected members in this May 2020 Council Agenda is the Local Fund Statement for the period 29th February to 27th March 2020. Information is provided on:

- Monthly receipts and payments for current period and same period last year.
- Cumulative receipts and payments for current year and last year.
- Details of main receipting areas and receipts over €1m for the current month and same period last year.
- Details of payroll payments and non-pay payments over €1m in the current month and same period last year.

Overview

Over the period 29th February to 27th March 2020 Dublin City Council made payments to the value of $\in 175.1$ m. Dublin City Council receipted $\in 173.5$ m of funds with an excess of payments over receipts of $\in 2.5$ m moving to a net debit balance at period end of $\in 33.9$ m. This value of $\in 33.9$ m is the maximum value applicable, as it includes the full value of payments made whether cashed or not. As at 27/03/2020, Dublin City Council had placed $\in 252$ m on investment. The net transfer to investments, in the period was $\in 66$ m. There were 5 weeks in March 2019 and 4 weeks in March 2020. As a consequence the absolute values of the 2019 period may be higher than the 2020 period.

Payments

During the period Dublin City Council made payments to the value of €175.1m. Contractor payments amounted to €16.6m. Payment of €7.8m was made to Irish Public Bodies Mutual Insurances for the 1st instalment of the Council's All Risks Insurance premium for 2020. €1.2m was paid to Marsh Ireland for 2020 Mortgage Protection Housing Loans repaid to DCC via mortgage repayments. Dublin City Council paid €7.6m to Homeless Voluntary Bodies (Simon Community, Peter McVerry Trust, Respond, DePaul Trust and Crosscare).

Payments for Payroll in March 2020, covering 2 fortnightly payments in 2020 compared to 3 in 2019, amounted to €23.7m for Salaries and Wages and a further €7.9m to Revenue in pay related taxes.

A further €3.5m was paid to the Revenue Commissioners for VAT, PSWT and RCT.

Receipts

During the period Dublin City Council receipted €172.5m. Commercial Rates receipted €26.2m compared to €57.5m for the same period in 2019.

Housing Rents receipted €7.2m and Housing Loans receipted €1.7m.

The value of the receipts from the Department of Housing, Planning and Local Government in the period have been exceptionally high. €103.2m was receipted from the DHPLG during the period. €64.2m was receipted for Homeless Recoupment, Section 10. €16.9m was receipted for the acquisition of local authority housing stock including €7m for Hampton Wood. Local Authority Housing Development receipts amounted to €6,2m which includes developments at Bunratty Road, Bonham Street and St. Teresa's Gardens. €4.7m was receipted for Voluntary Housing Bodies Funding for CALF, CAS and Leasing. RAS Rents receipts for the month of January was €1.3m. €6.4m was receipted for SHCEP Q2 2020. The Capital Loan Subsidy Scheme receipted €1.7m,

€8.9m was receipted from other Local Authorities. €1.7m with receipted from South Dublin County Council for the DFB Contribution for March 2020 and €1.1m for the balance of the final account for 2019. €1.4m was also receipted from Dunlaoghaire/Rathdown County Council for the DFB Contribution for March 2020. Fingal County Council's DFB Contribution January and February 2020 was €3.6m.

Irish Water receipted €3.6m, with €2.8m relating to Payroll, CMC Pension and CMC costs for Feb. 2020 compared to €4.5m in 2019 for January and February 2019. The lower values in 2020 being due to changes relating to fleet and reinstatements. Development Levies of €1.7m were receipted. Parking Meter Fees receipted €1.4m. €1.2m for Tags and Mobiles (3 weeks in 2020 compared to 5 weeks in 2019).

€1.6m was receipted from the Department of Rural and Community Affairs with €1.4m for Social Inclusion Community Assistance Projects (SICAP).

€2.3m was receipted from Transport Infrastructure Ireland for DFB wages for the Tunnel Response Vehicle in 2020.
