Ringsend Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Upgrading to senior playground• Line-marking of newly resurfaced basketball court• Undertake tree pruning/removal as required and supplement with additional tree planting, flower bulbs and wildflowers to enhance biodiversity in the park• Resurfacing 7-a-side synthetic pitch - quotations currently being sought
Tranquilla Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Upgrade playground
Neagh Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Playground repairs• Painting and repair of park Railings (SEAC Discretionary Fund)
Willie Pearse Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Playground repairs• Hurling wall – Tenders have been assessed and a preferred bidder identified. The contractor is currently preparing design documentation and a works programme for approval.
Eamon Ceannt Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Replacement of damaged play equipment• Undertake repairs to tennis court playing surface

Herbert Park	<p>Implementation of recommendations as set out in the Park Conservation Management Plan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prioritising the upgrading of the pond area and raised area overlooking the pond. • Install additional storage bays in Herbert Park Depot • Resurface bowling green – tender documents currently being prepared • Install flood lights at the synthetic football pitch • Annual treatment of pond algae • Bulb and pollinator planting to enhance Biodiversity
Bushy Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tearoom and bandstand upgrading - Part 8 obtained and tender documents currently being prepared • Woodland Management Plan to be tendered • Undertake annual treatment of pond algae
Pearse Square Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Railings to be painted (SEAC Discretionary Fund)
Cabbage Patch Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Park improvements
