With reference to a proposal to initiate the procedure for the extinguishment of the public right of way over that part of the lane to the rear of 1 to 24 Rathdown Road, Phibsborough, Dublin 7.

The legal procedure to extinguish the public right of way at the above location was initiated under Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.

## **Proposal**

A request to have the public right of way extinguished over that part of the lane to the rear of 1 to 24 Rathdown Road, Phibsborough, Dublin 7 has been made.

The reason for this extinguishment is to eliminate littering and anti-social behaviour in the laneway. The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached Drawing RM - 37516.

## <u>Statutory</u>

By public advertisement, dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 2020, representations or objections were invited to be received by or before the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July 2020. The site notices were erected on June 17<sup>th</sup> 2020.

No objections have been received.

## **Service Check**

A service check has been carried out and no service provider will need to alter the current services on or under the referred lane.

Accessibility arrangements, for such service providers, shall be made through the Central Area Office or those private customers that are engaged with that service provider(s).

## Resolution

That We, the Lord Mayor and Members of Dublin City Council, being the Roads Authority for the City of Dublin and being of the opinion that the Public Right of Way over that part of the lane to the rear of 1 to 24 Rathdown Road, Phibsborough, Dublin 7 as shown on the attached Drawing RM 37516 is no longer required for public use, extinguish the public right of way in accordance with Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.
