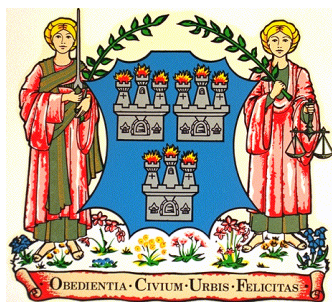

(c) Motion wording as revised, including proposed amendment/deletions

“That this council;

believes in the teeth of a Dublin lockdown, 80,000 mortgage holders currently on a Covid-19 payment break and the need to stimulate spending into the domestic economy, that the proposed 35% increase on what a Dublin homeowner paid for property tax last year, cannot be accepted;

calls on the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage to honour the commitment that all money collected from LPT locally in Dublin city will be retained locally for 2021 to bridge the gap in Dublin City Council’s finances;

acknowledges the huge deficit in Dublin City Council’s finances caused by the economic consequences of Covid-19 but recognises that this is not a burden that should be shouldered on the homeowners of Dublin city;

concludes that there should be no increase in a Dubliner’s property tax bill from what they paid last year and accordingly the status quo should remain with a 15% reduction on the basic rate of local property tax.
