Halloween Plan of Events for Ballyfermot / Drimnagh 2020

Events are very different this year and the local Youth Organisations and Community Groups have worked really hard to organise small, low key and local events to celebrate Halloween, while keeping young people safe.

The City Council are organising and supporting the following events, that comply with public health guidelines, in the Ballyfermot / Drimnagh area:

- 1. A "Think and be aware" Poster campaign commenced throughout Ballyfermot and Drimnagh on Monday 12th (6 to 8 Ft Corriboards ,copies attached)
- 2. 2000 keyrings and postcards promoting Halloween safety distributed to 11 primary schools throughout the area.
- 3. A scary House competition will be held in the Ballyfermot and Drimnagh with prizes for the best decorated houses.
- 4. A bulbs not bonfire campaign encouraging groups to plant daffodils in open spaces (poster attached)
- The Youth Services have planned a range of Day trips in the mid-term break leading up to Halloween to engage young people.
 All Youth Organisations will be open and running activities on Saturday the 31st.
- 6. Ballyfermot Youth Service host events in the skateboard Park and create a new mural on a public wall encouraging young people to wear masks.
- 7. Familibase and the Candle Trust are organising events targeting their young people to keep them occupied in the lead up to Halloween.
- 8. Cherry Orchard integrated Youth Service are organising an outdoor event for the children from Orchard Meadows.
- 9. St. John Bosco Youth Drimnagh are organising: A mural, a Staged and timed fitness test and targeted work with Youth on Halloween Day.
- 10. Drimnagh Residents group, supported by the Council, are displaying Halloween Themed art in Brickfield Park.
