While initially targeting Dublin-based businesses, the program rollout has subsequently been extended nationwide and has grown to include circular economy events and webinars, a mentoring service and a CE Innovation Award. Between 2019 and 2020, 96 companies received Circular Economy training under the MODOS program across the country, and the initiative has been awarded by INAC as Best Practice. The MODOS training has been delivered in Cork between February and March 2021 as the result of a collaboration with Cork Chamber of Commerce. MODOS will be delivered as well in the Dublin8 area between April and May 2021 as a result of a collaboration with DCC South Central Area Office and The Dublin Hub.
