**Naming & Numbering Proposal for a new residential development on the
site of 52, 54, 56 & 58 Station Road, Raheny, Dublin 5
Planning Reference: SHD0024/20 & ABP 305882-20 – Condition 6
1-105 Barlow Hall, Station Road, Raheny, Dublin 5**

This is a new residential development by Earlsfort Centre Developments on a site at 52, 54, 56 and 58 Station Road, Raheny, Dublin 5. (DCC Planning Reference SHD0024/20 & An Bord Pleanála Reference 305882-20). The development will consist of 105 apartments in 4 blocks, A, B, C & D as shown on the attached drawing **SM-2021-0275**.

The developer wishes to use the name “Barlow Hall” for the name of this SHD development after the writer Jane Barlow (1856-1917) who lived in Raheny House (previously known as the Cottage and later known as Rathmore). which was demolished to make way for a suburban housing scheme. The house was adjacent to this new SHD site. The proposal is as follows:

Block A, B, C & D Barlow Hall, Station Road, Raheny, Dublin 5/ Bloc A, B, C & D Halla Barlow, Bóthar an Stáisiúin, Ráth Eanaigh, Baile Átha Cliath 5.
