In terms of ramps, the road contains a number of ramps. The number of ramps and their distance apart are deemed the most appropriate in order to provide maximum effectiveness. 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13 7020423	Traffic Calming	TOLKA ROAD (C)	Dublin 3	Traffic calming measures due to "rat-running" from Clonliffe Road		With regards to the request for traffic calming on Tolka Road and onto Orchard Road, it has been reported that these roads are used as a rat-run for traffic. Following an inspection it is noted that Tolka Road and Orchard Roads are residential in nature. The roads are quite narrow and contain parking on the carriageway which offers traffic calming by reducing the available carriageway width for motorists and increases driver caution. Tolka Road and Orchard Road are located within the 30kph Slow Zone as part of (Phase 4) Part C of the Dublin City Council Speed Limit Review, signage of which is located on entrance to 30k roads as a motorist leave the 50k road. A speed survey was recently carried out and it was noted that for a 30kph road, the 85th percentile average speed was below the speed limit at 29kph. It is also noted that traffic volumes were small with an average of 8.5 vehicles passing through per hour. Due to this, no additional traffic calming measures are recommended at this time. Please note, a Pay & Display & Permit Parking scheme has recently been voted in by residents on Distillery Road and upon installation, will aid with regulation and consistency of parking along the road which aids traffic calming.		10/05/2021 0
