

Dominic Street Lower


Works in the month of May 2021 include the following:

Works on-going.

Constitution Hill

A couple of site meetings have taken place with Dublin City Architects, Grafton Architects and DCC Housing & Maintenance.

One to one meetings with residents are on-going to discuss the redevelopment of the complex.

Update letters regarding the redevelopment will be issued to all tenants on a regular basis.

Blackhall Queen Street Complex

Works to the roofs have been completed.

The five entrance doors onto Queen Street are in the process of getting new mag locks fitted. Keys will be issued to tenants once these locks have been fitted. These works will be completed by the end of June 2021.

Henrietta House

Estate management on-going meetings with Housing, Community and Residents regarding the Garden Project.

Tree surgeon will be on site in early June to remove ivy off the garden boundary wall. Once completed the wall will be painted.

New surface will be installed from Monday 31st May in the playground.

Hardwicke Street

The resurfacing works of the playground will commence in mid June 2021.

Estate Management are working closely with Men's Gardening Club.

Saint Michan's House

There are ongoing monthly meetings with two members of the residents association.

A new corral for euro bins to be installed opposite blocks C, D & E. In addition, bollards are to be installed outside the corral to ensure clear access to the bin area.

Drumalee Estate

The Muga pitch fencing was vandalised over the May bank holiday weekend Repair works will involve the erecting of pallisade fencing.

Three sets of steel panels were erected and completed around the boundary walls of Drumalee Court for security reasons as requested by the residents.

Kevin Barry House

Estate Management and Community Section are working closely with the Residents to enhance the complex (e.g.plants, wooden-benches repair and painted).

An additional access gate will be installed to the communal area at Blocks 1-30.
