This area will be brought to the attention of our parking enforcement and will be asked to monitor the area closely Furthermore Dublin City Council do not install parking bays unless they are part of a Pay, Display and Permit parking Scheme. in order to proceed with a request to introduce Pay and Display and Permit Parking it will be necessary for the City Council to receive. in the first instance, written supporting evidence for the introduction of a Parking Scheme, such as a number of written requests or a signed petition from residents of the road, giving names and addresses, indicating their clear support for such a Scheme. Ideally, this should be 25% of the households concerned.
