With reference to a proposal to initiate the procedure for the extinguishment of the public right of way over a cul-de-sac off Findlater Place.

Proposal

A request to extinguish the public right of way over part of a cul-de-sac off Findlater Place, Dublin 1 (the referred cul-de-sac is otherwise known locally as Strong's Court) was received by the Central Area Office. On investigation, it was considered appropriate to initiate the procedure to eliminate problems with anti-social behaviour and the dumping of waste in and about the referred cul-de-sac. The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached drawing.

Service Checks

A service check will be undertaken to establish what (if any) services are located in the area as shown on the attached Drawing. Suitable arrangements will be put in place regarding all such services prior to completion of this proposal.

Statutory Requirement

The statutory procedure involves giving public notice of this proposal, in one or more newspapers circulating in the City and the affixing of that same notice at every public entry point to the referred area for a period of not less than 14 days. Any objections or representations made, and not withdrawn, shall be considered. The extinguishment of a public right of way is a function reserved to the elected members of the City Council.

Recommendation

I recommend that procedures be initiated under Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993 to extinguish the public right of way over the area indicated on attached Drawing.
