However it is noted that as the green is nearby, visibility of pedestrians is an important factor. Due to this, it is recommended to install double yellow lines in front of the green on Kempton Heath, south side, starting from Public Lamp Standard 5 extending west for 22m ending at Public Lamp Standard 6.
