The Community Officers continue to manage the Covid Support line as a priority.


The City Council has been in regular contact with the large number of residents / community groups throughout the summer.

Monthly clean-ups are now held and supported in Phibsborough, Glasnevin, Stoneybatter and Cabra.


We hope to encourage more groups to plan additional monthly clean-ups.


Drumalee Drive...new residents group forms....very hard working.
