Litter Hotline/CRM

In the period 1st July – 31st August 2021, **773 incidents** were reported via Litter Hotline/CRM for the Central Area.

In addition to the CRM incidents, the Public Domain crew carry out inspections of their assigned routes on a daily basis. They will collect any dumped bags/materials which is not reflected on the above figures.

The total tonnage of collected dumped items was:

- **41.86 tonne** for 1st 31st July.
- **40.05 tonne** 1st 31st August.

Community Clean-ups

Large amounts of Community Clean up equipment has been dropped off to **15** separate community groups during the months of July and August this also included the removal of bags from community clean ups.

Items included: blue bags, litter pickers, scutchers, gloves, hi vests, bag hoops, shovels, brushes.

<u>Halloween 2021 – Bonfire Material</u>

The Public Domain Unit is working in conjunction with Waste Management, Housing & An Gardaí Síochána to remove reported bonfire materials from around the area. To date the Public Domain has received **20** requests to remove bonfire material from different locations.



- · Preston Street





Bio Diversity Garden, Ballybough

Work has begun on turning the green area at the corner of Ballybough Road and Sackville Avenue in to a bio diversity garden. This work is being carried out through Parks and is being funded by the Public Domain office.





Responsible Waste Disposal Campaign:

Over the course of July and August the following streets were targeted to ascertain the level of residents that are disposing of their waste responsibly:
