Electrical Vehicle Charge Point (EVCP) strategy update

In 2020 Element Energy developed a draft Electrical Vehicle Charge Point (EVCP) strategy for the four Local Authorities (LAs) that make up the Dublin Metropolitan Area (DMA): Fingal, South Dublin, Dublin City and Dún Laoghaire–Rathdown (DLR).

The core principles of the strategy have now been approved by the Chief Executives of the four Dublin Local Authorities.

The DMA EVCP steering group also agreed to work together on an on-going basis to enable the provision of an optimal public charging network.

The next step is to consult more widely on the strategy and to refine how the strategy will be delivered. Consultants have been retained to carry out this piece of engagement with key stakeholders to the timeline as set out below:

12 to 24 September	Preparing to engage with Stakeholders
27 to 31 October	Engagement with Stakeholders
1 to 24 November	Recommendations for strategy implementation
End November	Final report

Work on finalising the engagement pack is being finalised week ending 24 September, with a view to the stakeholder consultation beginning week commencing 27 September.
