Commemoration Committee - Stardust Monument

An application for support and funding for a new Stardust memorial at Artane Place, formerly Butterly Business Park, was made to the Council by Alan Butler, architect, and Xestra Asset Management (who manage the property). The application was supported by drawings of the proposed location and memorial (circulated).

An amount of c.€100,000 was requested from the Council.

The matter was discussed by the Commemorations & Naming Committee at its meeting of 27th July 2021. The Committee was supportive of the proposal in principle, but noted that the proposal and the design would need to be acceptable to the Stardust families.

Councillor Mac Donncha and Councillor O'Toole undertook to discuss the matter with the families.

The Committee:

- 1. Agreed to refer the matter to the North Central Area Committee for further consideration and discussion with the families, and
- 2. Agreed to a proposal from management that the Council make a contribution of €50,000 towards the memorial (€25,000 each from the Area and from the Commemorations budget).
