### WHAT WE COULD BE

A thoughtful re-design of the street, by removing the central median and using the gained space for greening and wider footpaths, will create a safer and

healthier environment for the people who live here while also encouraging locals and visitors to use more sustainable modes of transport.



Removal of central median on Dorset St to widen footpaths and improve public realm

- Prioritise people over traffic and make the street safe
- Remove central median
- Use space gained to provide green/rest/pull-in spaces and separate cycle lane from road users
- Segregated Cycle lane joined to path with shared surface and dished
- Narrow junction to protect pedestrians and slow down road users
- Appropriate planting scheme for the enjoyment of residents and to improve air and sound quality
- Narrow road junctions
