During the assessment, the Engineer observed a stop sign at the junction of Rialto Street and the South Circular Road which provided good visibility. The Engineer did not encounter any difficulty with exiting on to the South Circular Road with the indented parking bay to the west of the junction or the installation of the new ticket machine. Based on this assessment it would not be recommended to make any changes at this point as the onus is on the motorist to drive with due care.
