With reference to a proposal to initiate the procedure for the Extinguishment of the Public Right of Way over the laneway know as Strong's Court off Findlater Place, Dublin 1.

Proposal

A request to have the public right of way extinguished over the above was made; the reason for this proposed extinguishment is to eliminate anti-social behaviour in the area, and to eliminate litter and dumping. The extent of this proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached Drawing RM 37690.

The Central Area Committee, at its meeting on the 14th September 2021, agreed to initiate the statutory procedure to extinguish the public right of way over this laneway under the provisions of Section 73 of the Roads Act 1993.

Statutory

By public advertisement on the 1st October 2021, representations or objections were invited by the 12th November 2021. The site notice at this location was erected on the 1st October 2021.

- No objections were received.

Service Check

A service check has been carried out and access is required by Eir. Accessibility arrangements for this service provider will be arranged.

Recommendation

I recommend that this Committee approve the extinguishment of the public right of way over the area shown on Drawing No. RM 37690, for consideration later by the City Council.

The extinguishment of a public right of way is a function reserved to the City Council.
