

# **Monthly Local Fund Statement**

# Background

Attached for consideration by the Elected Members in this January 2022 Council Agenda is the Local Fund Statement for the period 30<sup>th</sup> October to 26<sup>th</sup> November 2021. Information is provided on:

- Monthly receipts and payments for current period and same period last year.
- Cumulative receipts and payments for current year and last year.
- Details of main receipting areas and receipts over €1m for the current month and same period last year.
- Details of payroll payments and non-pay payments over €1m in the current month and same period last year.

### Overview

Over the period  $30^{th}$  October to  $26^{th}$  November 2021 Dublin City Council made payments to the value of  $\in$ 132.1m. Dublin City Council receipted  $\in$ 119.8m of funds with an excess of payments over receipts of  $\in$ 12.3m moving to a net debit balance at period end of  $\in$ 41.4m. This value of is  $\in$ 12.3m is the maximum value applicable, as it includes the full value of payments made whether cashed or not. As at 26/11/2021 Dublin City Council had placed  $\in$ 143.9m on investment. The net transfer *from* investments and refundable deposits was  $\in$ 29.9m.

There were 4 weeks in November 2021 and November 2020.

#### Receipts

During the period Dublin City Council receipted €119.8m.

€41.1m was receipted from the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage during the period as follow

- €12.9m for Homeless Expenditure Recoupment Section 10 2021 Q4 balancing
- €9.2m for Homeless Expenditure Recoupment Section 10 Covid 2021 Q3
- €2.3m for local authority housing acquisition of 9 units.
- €1.7m for local authority housing stock developments at North King Street and Sean Foster Place
- €6.3m for Voluntary Housing Bodies CALF and CAS
- €1.7m for Voluntary Housing Bodies Social Housing PPP
- €1.2m for RAS Rents for the month of September
- €3.6m for Homeless HAP payment for the month of August and September

€8m was receipted from the other Dublin local authorities during the period for their Dublin Fire Brigade Contribution as follows:

- South Dublin County Council €3.6m for October and November
- Dunlaoghaire Rathdown County Council €1.4m for the month of November and
- Fingal County Council €1.9m for the month of October.

Commercial Rates receipted €10.4m, Housing Rents €7.4m and Housing Loans €2.1m during the period.

€1.2m was receipted for Development Levies and €1.6m was receipted for Parking Meter Fees during the period with €1.2m for tags and mobiles.

€3m was receipted to Irish Water.

### **Payments**

During the period Dublin City Council made payments to the value of €119.8m.

€35.7m was paid to Contractors as follows:

- €7.1m to IPB Insurances for the 4<sup>th</sup> instalment of all risks insurance
- €1.3m to Cunningham Contracts Ireland Ltd for construction and refurbishment works at Cornamona Court, Ballyfermot.
- €1m to Duggan Bros. t/a Richmond Trading Company for construction and refurbishment works at Sean Foster Place, North King Street and Dominick Street
- €2.3m to Purcell Construction Ltd. for construction and refurbishment works at North City Operations Depot Consolidation
- €14.8m to Byrne Wallace Solicitors for deposits and balances in relation to the purchasing of 30 Part V units in Dublin Landings, Dublin 1
- €2.3m to Cluid for accelerated CALF for site purchase 49-53 Nth Great Charles Street
- Payments to Homeless Voluntary Bodies as follows:
  - ➤ €1.8m to Peter McVerry Trust for Q3 and Q4 funding
  - ➤ €1.5m to Crosscare for Q4 funding
  - > €3.7 to Dublin Simon Community for Q3 and Q4 funding
