## To: Each Local Authority

The following was resolved and agreed by the members at a meeting of Waterford City and County Council held on 13th January, 2022

"That the members of Waterford City and County Council:

- unequivocally supports the retention of a full-time air sea rescue service at Waterford Airport as currently provided by the crew of Rescue 117
- rejects any moves to end, restrict or reduce the service in the new 10 year air sea rescue contract
- believes that ending, restricting or reducing the service would negatively affect safety at sea, in the mountains and the overall safety of coastal communities on the South Coast coast.
- calls on the Minister for Transport Eamon Ryan to ensure the current service is retained in Waterford in the new 10 year contract"
