Recommended	<p>In terms of prohibitions such as double yellow lines on junctions, It is generally not recommended to provide double yellow lines at junctions as it can lead to a proliferation of measures when it is already illegal to park within 5m of a road junction. Road Traffic (Traffic & Parking) Regulations, Section 36, paragraph (2), "A vehicle shall not be parked: (c) within 5 metres of a road junction."</p> <p>However it is noted that there is persistent parking at the junction which impacts visibility and access and egress at the junction and further impacts on parking for local residents. To that end, it is recommended to install a Yield Sign (RUS 026) with associated road markings on Botanic Road at the junction with Botanic Avenue.</p> <p>The Yield sign will formalise the junction and will be accompanied by a Continuous Centre Line, RRM 001, extending longitudinally back from the junction for a minimum distance of 20m from the Yield Line as per the Traffic Signs Manual 2019. The provision of the Continuous Centre Line prevents vehicles from parking opposite the line and will remove any parking close to the junction.</p>	Councillor	29/11/2021	2
