**Litter Hotline/CRM**

In the period 1<sup>st</sup> February – 25<sup>th</sup> February 2022, incidents were reported via Litter Hotline/CRM for the Central Area.

In addition to the CRM incidents, the Public Domain crew carry out inspections of their assigned routes on a daily basis. Collecting any dumped bags/materials which is not reflected on the above figures.

The total tonnage of collected illegally dumped items by our 5 outdoor staff members was:

- **26.34 tonne** for 1<sup>st</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> February 2022.

Please note, last month an additional 4.68 tonne was collected after the February Area Committee report was submitted. Resulting in total tonnage for January being 30.68.

**Community Clean-ups**

Community Clean up equipment was distributed to 5 Community Groups / individuals between 1<sup>st</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> February. Requests for the removal of bags from community clean ups were looked after by Waste Management and Public Domain staff.

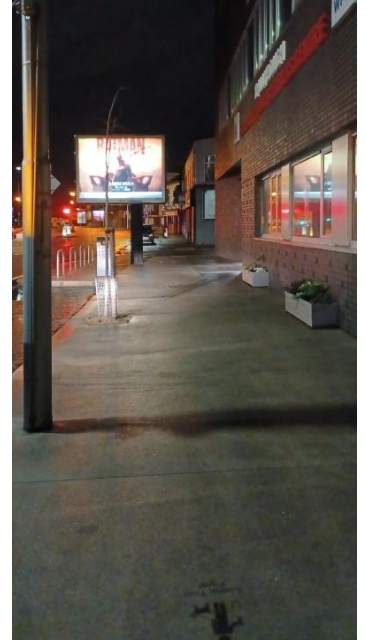
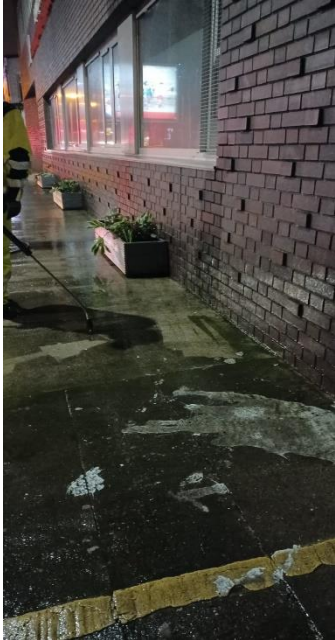
