5	7021885		Yield Sign (Rescind)	GRACE PARK HEIGHTS (NC)	Dublin 9	Take away the yield sign, put stop sign (if possible) on left hand side when you turn corner put half way down the road double yellow lines	Not Recommended	The existing Yield sign is appropriate in indicating priority at the junction concerned. Under the Road Traffic Regulations, traffic on a road ending at a T junction must give way to traffic from either direction on the other road. Stop / Yield signs are not necessary where normal rules of the road apply, moreover such signs/markings are only provided on approaches to major junctions, otherwise this would lead to a proliferation of signs throughout residential estates. Implementation of parking restrictions in form of double yellow lines on Grace Park Heights could create parking difficulties for the residents and may also result in an increase in speed in this residential area in accordance with DMURS guidelines.
