


### What is the Circular Economy?



- Alternative to Liner Take, Make, Discard model
- ❖ Inspired by nature less new materials in, less waste out
- Design out waste, keep materials in use, regenerate natural systems
- Lower materials use, Lower energy usage, lower water usage
- A Waste Action Plan for the Circular Economy & Whole of Government circular Economy Strategy published late 2020
- Circular Economy Bill published March 30<sup>th</sup> 2022

#### Climate Action and the Circular Economy





- Energy 55% / Materials & Land Use (Agriculture) 45% (EMC)
- ❖ Industrial systems & Land use
- Extraction/Production/Usage
- $\clubsuit$  Buying 1 white shirt =  $CO_2$  35kms driving
- ❖ 5 really, really important areas Cement, aluminum, steel, plastics, and food
- ❖ These emissions are complex, awkward, harder to reduce than those of energy production or transport
- According to the UN Environment Statistics, a fully circular economy would both cut down our resource use by 28% and reduce carbon emissions by 72%.

- ❖ Q3 2022 Local Authority sector approval to proceed to statutory public consultation (8 weeks min.)
- Q4 2022 Executive adoption/publication

# Food Waste Separation Roadshow – Targeted Advertising

- Minister Smith has announced that GOI will fund the purchase & distribution of approx. 300,000 food waste separation packs for Irish Households over a two year period commencing 2022
- This pilot seeks to investigate household interaction, venues & locations, quality of product along with communications



#### Schools Composting Project

- ❖ 4 Dublin Councils are involved in a large Schools Composting Project
- Project is being run over 2 years
- ❖ Over 100 schools are involved plus a waiting list
- Each school will get a composting system including a compost area and wormery and equipment ie. caddies, liners
- Project includes a suite of resources for schools including web site, video tutorials,
   master composter training, online repository (base camp), class room materials, school visits

- Initiative of the Regional Waste Management Planning Office and DCC Economic Development Office
- Circular Economy Training programme designed for SMEs operating in Ireland
- ❖ 80+ businesses participated in the training course
- 2021 Webinars, Mentoring, Circular Innovation award
- March/April 2022 course just complete DCC & DLRCC funded by EPA



#### Climate KIC Circular City Accelerator

- ❖ EIT European Institute of Innovation and Technology funding
- EIT Climate-KIC is a Knowledge and Innovation Community (KIC), working to accelerate the transition to a zero-carbon, climate-resilient society.
- Tangent Trinity College Dublin Trinity's Ideas Workspace Innovation and Entrepreneurship
- Dublin, Athens, Berlin, Copenhagen
- This Accelerator project aims to give European cities access to innovative talent (start-ups) from across Europe to help to develop solutions to circular challenges.
- The project activities include acceleration training for start-ups, match-making with problem-owners (cities!), possibility of investment.
