Mary Hayes, Director DRHE, provided a presentation on the draft Statutory Homeless Action Plan 2022-24. The following considerations were raised:

- Flexibility in light of national and global events such as the war in Ukraine and its resulting migrant crisis
- Consistent rise in homelessness amongst single adults
- Prison discharges as a vulnerable cohort with regard to overdose
- Learnings to be gained through working with the HRB on what may be done to prevent deaths
- Migrant homelessness and how this growing cohort may be supported
- The role of the Outreach/Intake teams as on-street services on behalf of the DRHE
- Research to be considered on employment levels amongst those experiencing homelessness
- The recruitment of a single point of contact for DV groups to be considered.

The next meeting will take place on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022, with Housing First in the Dublin Region to be the topic.
