
A Chairde,

I write to inform you that the members of Kerry County Council at their recent meeting adopted the following resolution.

“That Kerry County Council write to the Minister for Health, Mr. Stephen Donnelly, the Oireachtas Health Committee and the HSE, CEO Mr. Paul Reid, as well as our Regional Health Board and local hospitals, requesting that the provision of Long Covid Clinics are retained and expanded and that we acknowledge that thousands of people are suffering with adverse effects from Covid19 for long periods of time. Unfortunately, the health supports that are needed for those suffering are not in abundances or widely available with the threat of some services which are in place being withdrawn.”

It was agreed to circulate this motion to all local authorities for their attention and consideration.
