CENTRAL AREA DISCRETIONARY FUND 2022 – PROGRESS REPORT

A fund of €330,000 was approved in Budget 2022 for each of the two Central Area LEAs, **North Inner City** and **Cabra Glasnevin**.

The process of allocating this fund was initiated in mid-January. All Members participated in the process and an extensive list of projects was compiled. Following the allocation process, the attached list of projects was agreed for delivery in 2022, as notified to Councillors at the March area committee meeting.

Work has progressed through the year on delivery of the projects and a summary status report is as set out below. For ease of reference each line item has been colour coded as follows:

	Green – Project Completed
	Yellow – In progress and on track for delivery
	Red – Unlikely to be delivered and recommended for re-allocation

In the main, projects have either been delivered or are on track for delivery in 2022.

It is a matter for the Councillors to decide whether to hold the allocation and await the outcome of projects coloured red or to re-allocate.

A final report on the Discretionary Fund 2022 will be brought to the December Committee as part of the End of Year financial processes.
