



**With reference to the proposed renaming of the laneway known as
Love Lane North to Bealach Seosaimh Mhic Thréinfhir /Joseph Traynor Way**

The following motion was proposed by Cllr Nial Ring and agreed by the Central Area Committee at its meeting on 11th February 2020.

“That the Central Area Committee agree that the roadway behind the refurbished houses on Ballybough Road be named after Joseph Traynor, a 19 year old who was shot by the RIC/Black and Tans in Croke Park killed on Bloody Sunday (21st November 1920) and who was taken to a house on Sackville Gardens (Ring’s) where he bled on the kitchen table. He was then brought through the back lane (Love Lane) and out on to Sackville Avenue before he was collected by ambulance. Joseph Traynor died in Jervis Street hospital that evening.”

In accordance with Section 189 (1) of the Local Government Act 2001 the permission of members was sought to initiate the process to change the name of a laneway as indicated on Map Index No. SM-2022-0352 from Love Lane North to *Bealach Seosaimh Mhic Thréinfhir/Joseph Traynor Way*. There were no objections to the proposal and the motion was passed.

There are no residents on the electoral register on the laneway nor are there any rated occupiers, therefore a plebiscite was not deemed necessary.

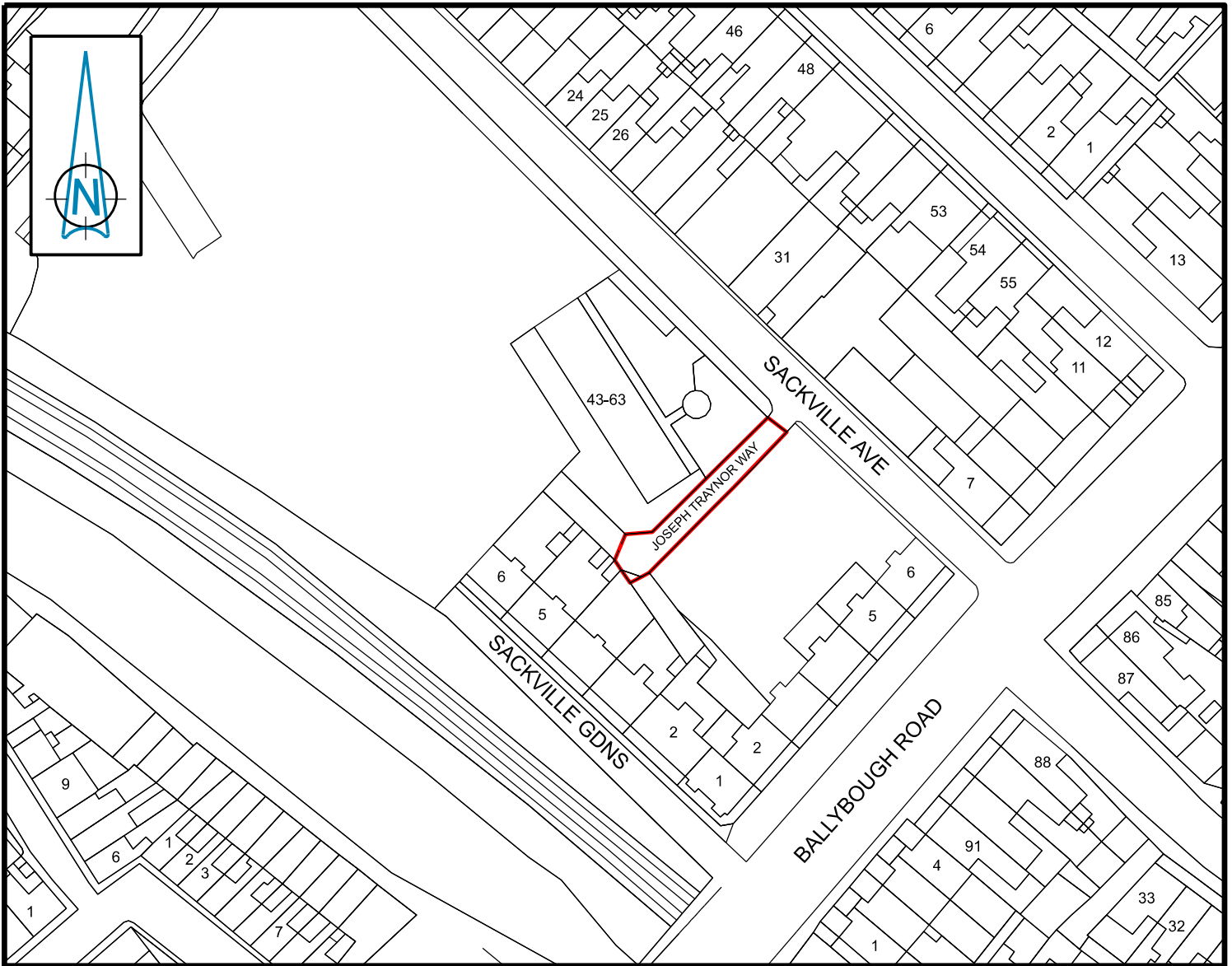
In accordance with Section 189 (4) of the Local Government Act 2001 notice of the proposed change of place name was published in the Dublin Gazette on 24th June 2021, submissions on the proposal were open to be made up to 24th August 2021. Three notices were placed at the entrances to the laneway. No submissions were received.

It is in order therefore for the Lord Mayor to formally make a declaration that the renaming of “Love Lane North” to “*Bealach Seosaimh Mhic Thréinfhir/Joseph Traynor Way*” that will be formally known as *Bealach Seosaimh Mhic Thréinfhir/Joseph Traynor Way* with effect from 1st January 2024.

Declaration:

That I Caroline Conroy, Lord Mayor of Dublin, under Section 189 of the Local Government Act formally declare the renaming of “Love Lane North” to “*Bealach Seosaimh Mhic Thréinfhir/Joseph Traynor Way*” that will be formally known as *Bealach Seosaimh Mhic Thréinfhir/Joseph Traynor Way* with effect from 1st January 2024.
