PUBLIC DOMAIN REPORT

IBAL Report

The first IBAL report of 2023 was released in early January. Ballymun was listed as 36 out of 40 towns surveyed.

Ballymun has retained its overall position. The report highlighted that Balbutcher Lane remains by far the most heavily littered site due to the dumping at the various entrances to the former Ballymun Towers.

Actions on foot of the report: Public Domain Section during the month of December introduced the following enhancements; painting of original entrances and removal of overgrowth to the old flats site. A meeting was held with Kellogg Ireland to adopt the stretch along Balbutcher lane entrances.

The Public Domain Section surveyed other locations mentioned outside Axis and adjacent areas which have now been forwarded to the Waste Management Section for action.

Overall Ballymun received 3 Grade As, 4 Grade Bs, 2 Grade C+, And 1 Grade D
