Recommended	Based on the assessment of the TAG Area Engineer it is recommended to Install Double Yellow Lines (RRM 008) on the southern carriageway of Bluebell Road, between the northern boundaries of property No. 47 La Touche Drive and No. 66 La Touche Road, in order to (1) protect the cycle stands and users of the disabled parking bays (2) to relieve the congestion along Bluebell Road. As a long-term solution, the Area Engineer recommends that a Pay & Display and Permit parking scheme be installed on Bluebell Road to alleviate traffic congestion and promote good parking behaviour. Since the road is only 6.3m wide, it qualifies for one-sided parking only. Double Yellow Lines would be installed on the opposite side of the road to the P&D and Permit parking scheme. It is important for the customer to be aware that reducing congestion on one road will move the congestion onto other roads. Therefore, if a P&D and Permit parking scheme is installed on Bluebell Road, the Area Engineer recommends installing P&D and Permit parking on all roads in the area. To introduce a scheme, it will be necessary for Dublin City Council to receive a signed petition from at least 35% of households, giving names and address, indicating that they want a P&D and Permit parking scheme installed. The Area Engineer observed that the road is quite busy and the Double Yellow Lines are needed for a buffer zone in order to allow vehicles going in opposite directions to pass. It is not recommended to rescind the Double Yellow Lines and install a single yellow line on the southside of Jamestown Road for the same reason as before.
