Dublin City Heritage Forum – invitation to Arts Culture Leisure and Recreation SPC

Dear Cllr. O'Driscoll,

Dublin City Council is establishing a **Heritage Forum** to support the implementation of the Dublin City Strategic Heritage Plan 2023 - 2028. I am seeking expressions of interest from two members of the Arts Culture Leisure and Recreation SPC to sit on forum. Nominations can come from either the Council members or from members representing outside bodies.

As stipulated in Heritage Ireland 2030 a Heritage Forum is a non-statutory advisory group established by the Local Authority to provide advice to the authority on the formation and implementation of a Heritage Plan.

The **Dublin City Heritage Forum** will comprise a maximum of twelve members. It will include two nominations from the Arts Culture Leisure and Recreation SPC and two from the Planning and Urban Form SPC. It will also include representatives of the architectural heritage, archaeology and Cultural Heritage working groups established in 2021 to inform the writing of the Dublin City Strategic Heritage Plan. The Forum will meet twice a year. I include the relevant terms of reference with this letter.

The Draft Strategic Heritage Plan has undergone AA and SEA screening and will go on public display later this month. It is envisaged the forum will have its first meeting before the end of March 2023.

I look forward to receiving your two nominations.
