The criteria for the installation of ramps are: • The road should have a straight run of at least 200 metres. • The 85th percentile speed should be greater than the posted speed limit. • Traffic volumes should exceed 60 vehicles per hour. • There should be genuine road safety concerns, based either on actual accident statistics or on observed road safety patterns, or a written report from an inspector of the Garda Traffic Division of the local Garda Síochána relating to an issue of safety.
